Tuesday: Seeing With Faith

Hebrews 11:1 – Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see.

James 1:5 (ESV) – If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask God, who gives generously to all without reproach, and it will be given him.

Good judgment comes from trusting in the Lord and not relying solely on your own understanding. It's easy to be swayed by worldly perspectives, but God's wisdom surpasses all. Allow Him to guide your decisions and lead you along the right path. With His wisdom, your judgement will be sound and your choices blessed.

Prayer: Heavenly Father, guide my thoughts and decisions at align with Your will and purpose for my life.

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Sunday: Joy in Every Moment

Psalm 118:24 (ESV) – This is the day that the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad in it.

Joy is not dependent on external circumstances, but rather a choice to find gratitude in every moment. Look for His blessings, the beauty in nature, and the love of those around you. Choos to approach each day with a heart full of joy, knowing that God is present and working in every situation.
