Devotions 2025: November 3 to November 9

For daily devotions I am going to start using <u>60 days of prayer</u> published by Guideposts.

Monday: Hearing God's Whisper

Isaiah 31:21 – Whether you turn to the right or to the left, your ears will hear a voice behind you, saying, "This is the way; walk in it."

Often we sense God's presence not through a loud voice but in a whisper; soft words spoken to the heart, a quiet prompting, or a subtle shift in our thoughts. The pard part is slowing down enough to hear it. Maybe you have been waiting for a sign, straining to hear something unmistakable. But what if He is already speaking, just softer than expected? Maybe in the stillness of a morning prayer. In the kindness of a stranger. In the deep-down assurance that you are not alone. Take a breath and make space. His whisper is there, guiding you, leading you forward.

Prayer: Dear Lord, remind me o pause, seek You, and trust the gentle whisper of Your guidance.

Tuesday: Release Control

Matthew 16:25 – "For whoever wants to save their life will lose it, but whoever loses their life or me will find it."

True freedom comes when you release your grip and say, "God, I trust You more than I trust myself." Surrendering is an act of courage and faith.
