Monday: Just Enough for a Miracle

1 Kings 17:16 – The jar of flour was not used up and the jug of oil did not run dry.

A widow gave her last bit of flour to the prophet Elijah, and God made it stretch day after day. Her simple act of obedience opened the way for God's ongoing provision. In our own lives, when we give what we have, even if it feels like it is not enough, God meets us with abundance. Faith is not about having everything figured out. It is about trusting the One who does.

Prayer: Dear Lord, I give You what I have. Even when it feels small, I place it in Your hands. Strengthen my faith and remind me that You are always enough.
